Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1384

Amend House Bill No. 1384 as engrossed, S3/27/13 (version: 03/27/2013
3:45:48 PM):

Page 2, delete lines 20 through 24 and substitute the following:

"(c)(1) The Department of Human Services shall:

(A) Require a state criminal background check of a caregiver and of an applicant to become a caregiver by the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police that conforms to the applicable standards and includes the taking of fingerprints; and

(B) For a person who has not resided continuously in Arkansas during the previous five (5) years, require a federal criminal background check of a caregiver and of an applicant to become a caregiver by the Federal Bureau of Investigation that conforms to the applicable standards and includes the taking of fingerprints."
