Page 2, line 20, delete "(b)" and substitute "(b)(1)"

AND

Page 2, line 22, delete "(1)" and substitute "(A)"

AND

Page 2, line 24, delete "(2)" and substitute "(B)"

AND

Page 2, line 26, delete "(3)" and substitute "(C)"

AND

Page 2, delete line 27 and substitute:

"social media account.

(2) If an employer inadvertently receives an employee's
username, password, or other login information to the employee's social media
account through the use of an electronic device provided to the employee by
the employer or a program that monitors an employer's network the employer is
not liable for having the information but may not use the information to gain
access to an employee's social media account."
