**Subtitle of House Bill No. 1902**

TO PROHIBIT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION FROM REQUIRING OR REQUESTING A  
CURRENT OR PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEE OR STUDENT FROM DISCLOSING HIS OR HER USERNAME  
OR PASSWORD FOR A SOCIAL MEDIA ACCOUNT.

**Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1902**

Amend House Bill No. 1902 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 2, delete "an account" and substitute "a personal account"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 12 through 15 and substitute:

"(B) "Social media account" does not include an account:  
(i) Opened by an employee or student at the request of an  
institution of higher education;  
(ii) Provided to an employee or student by an institution  
of higher education, such as an institutional email account or other software  
program owned or operated exclusively by an institution of higher education;  
(iii) Setup by an employee or student on behalf of an  
institution of higher education; or  
(iv) Setup by an employee or student to impersonate an  
institution of higher education through the use of the institution's name,  
logos, or trademarks."

AND

Page 3, delete line 8 and substitute:

"that is publicly available on the Internet.  
(e) Nothing in this section prevents an institution of higher  
education from complying with the requirements of federal or state laws,  
rules, or regulations."
