Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1927

Amend House Bill No. 1927 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 26 through 36 and substitute:

"6-16-135. Personal Economics and personal finance course content.

(a) The Department of Education, in consultation with the Department of Workforce Education <u>Department of Career Education</u>, subject to the approval of the State Board of Education, shall develop <u>economics and</u> personal finance course content guidelines and recommend textbooks to be used in <u>an economics course or</u> a personal finance course.

(b) The course content shall include, but not be limited to, household budgets creation, checking accounts maintenance, basic consumer finance, debt management, credit management, insurance, and taxes. By the 2014-2015 school year, the course content guidelines for the economics credit required for high school graduation shall include the following material concerning personal finance:"


