Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2174

Amend House Bill No. 2174 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-41-217, concerning individualized education programs for students with disabilities, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(d) A school shall grant a student academic credit for coursework the student completed at a residential treatment center or a day treatment center that is recommended under the student's individualized education program required under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq., 504 plan required under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, 29 U.S.C. § 794, or Title II plan required under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act, 42 U.S.C. §§ 12131 - 12165, as those laws existed on January 1, 2013."
