Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 1040

Amend Senate Bill No. 1040 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following:
 "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-101(a), concerning polling sites
designated by the county board of election commissioners, is amended to read
as follows:
 (a)(1) The county board of election precincts; and
 (B)(i) Designate a polling site for each precinct.
 (ii) A polling site may serve two (2) or more
precincts, including parts of precincts.
 (iii) The county board of election commissioners may
designate a retail store owned by a private entity as a polling site.
 (2) Except as provided in § 6-14-106, the designation of polling
sites shall be by a unanimous vote of the members of the county board
present.
