Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 1060

AN ACT REGULATING THE RECOVERY OF DAMAGES SUSTAINED AS A RESULT OF AN ACCIDENT
INVOLVING THE OPERATION OF AN UNINSURED VEHICLE.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 1060

Amend Senate Bill No. 1060 as originally introduced:

Add Senator Files as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Delete the title of the bill in its entirety and substitute the following:

"AN ACT TO PROTECT THE INSURED DRIVERS OF ARKANSAS; TO ENCOURAGE COMPLIANCE
WITH THE MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE LAWS OF ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO PROTECT THE INSURED DRIVERS OF
ARKANSAS; AND TO ENCOURAGE COMPLIANCE WITH
THE MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE
LAWS OF ARKANSAS."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 28 through 36 and substitute the following:

"27-22-112. Accidents between insured and uninsured motorists.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, in a civil
action filed by or on behalf of a person who at the time of an accident
involving the operation of a motor vehicle did not comply with § 27-22-104
and the Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act, § 27-19-101 et seq., to
recover damages arising from the accident or for any claim against the motor
vehicle liability insurance coverage of an insured party to the accident, a
person who at the time of the accident complied with § 27-22-104 and the
Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act, § 27-19-101 et seq., may be held
liable only for medical costs, property damage, and lost income."



AND

Page 2, line 20, delete "motorist" and substitute "insured motorist"

AND

Page 2, line 26, delete "claimed" and substitute "claimed or was eligible to be claimed"

AND

Page 2, delete line 36, and substitute the following:
"(c) This section may be"

AND

Page 3, line 2, delete "person" and substitute "insured person"
