Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 134

Amend Senate Bill No. 134 as originally introduced:

SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that abortions are currently being</u> <u>performed in Arkansas on unborn children with detectable heartbeats; and</u> <u>that this act is immediately necessary because to protect the lives of unborn</u> <u>children with detectable heartbeats. Therefore, an emergency is declared to</u> <u>exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the</u> <u>public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:</u>

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
