## Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 542

## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 542

Amend Senate Bill No. 542 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 13 through 18 and substitute the following: "(ii)(a) Any weekly benefits payable subsequent to the date of delivery or mailing the determination shall be <u>terminated</u>. (b) The <u>termination</u> shall apply only to benefits payable within the benefit year of the claim with respect to which the claimant willfully made a false statement or misrepresentation;"

AND

Page 2, line 20, delete "five (5)" and substitute "five (5) two and one-half  $(2 \ 1/2)$ "

AND

Page 2, delete lines 25 through 32 and substitute the following:
 "(b) Upon request of the Legislative Council, the Department of
Workforce Services shall provide reports regarding unemployment insurance
claim fraud and its efforts to prevent the fraud."
