AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2014-2015 FISCAL YEAR.

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1130

Amend House Bill No. 1130 as engrossed, (version: 02/13/2014 3:40:37 PM):

Page 9, Line 18, delete "8,998,984" and insert "10,998,984"

AND

Page 9, Line 20, delete "__\$321,538,442" and insert "__\$323,538,442"

AND

Page 13, insert additional SECTIONS immediately following SECTION 15 to read as follows:

" SECTION 16. APPROPRIATION - BREAST CARE PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Health, to be payable from the paying account as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Breast Care Program of the Department of Health which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 5 of Act 1375 of 2013, the following:

SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING TRANSFER FOR BREAST CARE PROGRAM. Immediately upon the effective date of this Section and upon the continuation of funding for the "Health Care Independence Program" established under the Health Care Independence Act of 2013, § 20-77-2401 et seq., the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) from the unobligated funds in the General Improvement Fund to the Department of Health paying account as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to provide funds for the Breast Care Program appropriation provided herein."



AND

Delete SECTION 34 - EMERGENCY CLAUSE in its entirety and substitute the following:

SECTION 34. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the exception that SECTIONS 16 and 17 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, and that in the event of an extension of the Legislative Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014, with the exception that SECTIONS 16 and 17 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014; with the exception that SECTIONS 16 and 17 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval."

Appropriately renumber all SECTION numbers of the bill.
