TO AMEND THE PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR DISABLED VETERANS, SURVIVING SPOUSES, AND MINOR DEPENDENT CHILDREN.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1176

Amend House Bill No. 1176 as originally introduced:

sells his or her home, the exemption shall be prorated to the date of sale so that the disabled veteran shall owe no owes no tax for the portion of the year he or she claimed the home as a homestead, and the purchaser shall be is liable only for taxes relating to the balance of the year.

(b) If a disabled veteran purchases a home that qualifies as a homestead, the exemption shall be prorated to the date of sale so that the disabled veteran owes no tax for the portion of the year he or she claimed the home as a homestead, and the seller is liable only for the taxes relating to the balance of the year.

(b) (c) Upon request by the disabled veteran, the county collector shall make such record entries as may be necessary to effect the proration."
