## Subtitle of House Bill No. 1566

TO ALLOW PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANTS THE OPTION OF WORKING MORE THAN FORTY (40) HOURS PER WEEK UNDER THE ARKANSAS MEDICAID PROGRAM.

## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1566

Amend House Bill No. 1566 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 77, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows: <u>20-77-131. Personal care attendants.</u> (a) As used in this section, "personal care attendant" means a person who: <u>(1) Has been hired directly by a Medicaid beneficiary without</u> interaction with a third-party organization or agency; and <u>(2) Provides personal care services through a home- or</u> community-based waiver program funded by Medicaid. <u>(b) A personal care attendant may work more than forty (40) hours per</u> week under the Arkansas Medicaid Program. <u>(c)(1) If a personal care attendant works more than forty (40) hours</u> per week, the personal care attendant is not eligible for time-and-a-half pay or overtime pay under § 11-4-211.

(2) However, the personal care attendant is eligible for regular hourly pay based on the hours worked over forty (40) hours per week."
