## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1754

Amend House Bill No. 1754 as originally introduced:

Page 6, delete lines 7 through 13, and substitute the following:

"(d) At the permanency planning hearing on a juvenile sixteen (16)

years of age or older, the court shall ask the juvenile his or her desired

permanency outcome, or the attorney ad litem shall enter evidence concerning
the child's wishes."

Page 7, delete lines 18 through 29, and substitute the following:

"(D)(i) The parent, guardian, or custodian and juvenile may choose additional members to be part of the case planning team.

(ii) The department may reject a selected individual for good cause."

Page 8, delete line 13, and substitute the following: "juvenile in a developmentally appropriate and age-appropriate way."
