"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-9-112 is amended to read as follows: 12-9-112. County sheriff as law enforcement officer.

Any <u>A</u> former county sheriff of a county who <u>has</u> served as county sheriff within that county for at least <u>ten (10)</u> <u>eight (8)</u> years <u>and who meets all</u> <u>minimum hiring standards prescribed by the Arkansas Commission on Law</u> <u>Enforcement Standards and Training shall be deemed is</u> qualified to be employed as a law enforcement officer for any municipality located within that county, notwithstanding any law or regulation to the contrary with a municipality, county, or state board."
