## Amendment No. 2 to House Joint Resolution No. 1024

Amend House Joint Resolution No. 1024 as engrossed, H3/4/15 (version: 03/04/2015 09:47:30 AM):

Page 2, delete lines 33 through 36, and substitute the following:

" $\underline{(a)(1)}$  In case of the impeachment of the Governor, or his <u>or her</u> removal from office, death, inability to discharge the powers and duties of the said office, <u>or</u> resignation <del>or absence from the State</del>, the powers and duties of the office, shall devolve upon the Lieutenant Governor for the residue of the term, or until the disability shall cease.

(2)(A) If the Governor is absent from the state, he or she may designate the Lieutenant Governor to act as Governor until the Governor returns to the State.

(B) A designation under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this

section:

(i) Shall be made in writing to the Secretary of

State; and

(ii) Shall expire upon the earlier of:

(a) The Governor's return to the state; or

(b) The Governor's delivery of a written

revocation of the designation to the Secretary of State.


(b) But when the Governor shall, with the consent of the Legislature, be out of the State, in time of war, at the head of a military force thereof, he <u>or she</u> shall continue commander-in-chief of all the military force of the State."

Page 3, delete lines 1 through 4

AND

Page 4, line 19, delete "<u>subsection (b)</u>" and substitute "<u>subsections (b) and (c)</u>"



AND

Page 4, delete line 21, and substitute the following:

"(b) Section 2 of this amendment shall become effective on January 1,

2017.

(c) A candidate for Lieutenant Governor shall run jointly with a"
