SECTION 5. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u> <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the under Amendment 94 the</u> <u>Independent Citizens Commission submitted a recommendation regarding expense</u> <u>reimbursement to the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of</u> <u>the Senate; that the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of</u> <u>the Senate in coordination with the Independent Citizens Commission are</u> <u>implementing the recommendations submitted; and that this act is immediately</u> <u>necessary to ensure that provisions of Amendment 94 are carried out in</u> <u>accordance with its language . Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist,</u> <u>and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public</u> <u>peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:</u>

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
