## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 154

AND

Page 4, line 1, delete "<u>no more</u>" and substitute "<u>not counted in the average</u> <u>daily membership of a school district</u>"

AND

Page 4, line 2, delete "than fifty-four (54) years of age"

AND

Page 4, delete lines 4 and 5 and substitute:
"(1) Earned a high school diploma; and"

AND

Page 4, line 23, delete "The Department" and substitute "(a) The Department"

AND Page 4, line 24, delete "<u>public charter schools</u>" and substitute "<u>charter</u> schools"

Page 4, line 30, delete "curriculum requirements" and substitute "graduation competencies in core subjects"

AND

Page 4, delete line 32 and substitute:

AND

"(4) Reporting requirements.

(b) The department shall adopt a rule establishing the minimum graduation requirements for an adult education charter school to issue a high school diploma that substantially meets or exceeds the basic graduation competencies in core subjects expected by the State Board of Education for public school students."
