TO PERMIT A COUNTY EMPLOYEE WHO WORKS IN THE COURTHOUSE AND WHO IS ALSO A
CONCEALED CARRY LICENSEE TO CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN IN A COUNTY COURTHOUSE.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 159

Amend Senate Bill No. 159 as originally introduced:

Add Senators A. Clark, Files, Flippo, B. Johnson, B. King, Rice, G. Stubblefield, E. Williams, and J. Woods as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Add Representative M. Gray as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 1, delete line 36, and substitute the following:

"(5)(A) Any courthouse, courthouse annex or other building owned, leased, or regularly used by a county for conducting court proceedings or housing a county office unless:

(i) The licensee is either:

(a) Employed by the county; or

(b) A countywide elected official; and

(ii) The licensee's principal place of employment is within the courthouse, the courthouse annex or other building owned, leased, or regularly used by the county for conducting court proceedings or housing a county office.

(B) The quorum court by ordinance may approve a plan that allows licensees permitted under this subdivision (5) to carry a concealed handgun into the courthouse as set out by the local security and emergency preparedness plan;
