
Page 1, delete lines 34 through 36

AND

Page 2, delete line 1 and substitute the following: "(B) Uses a motor vehicle or motorcycle designed, equipped, or marked with an emblem, logo, marking, decal, insignia, or design so as to resemble a motor vehicle or motorcycle belonging to a federal, state, or local law enforcement agency or law enforcement officer."
