Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 863

Amend Senate Bill No. 863 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 16, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows: <u>14-16-117. Controlled burns.</u> <u>A property owner may conduct a controlled burn of a residence on the</u> <u>property owner's property in the county if:</u> <u>(1) The property owner applies to the quorum court of that</u> <u>county and the fire department that is responsible for providing fire</u> <u>protection services for the property for approval to conduct the controlled</u> <u>burn; and</u> <u>(2) The application under subdivision (1) of this section is</u> approved by the quorum court and the fire department."
