## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1297

Amend House Bill No. 1297 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 32, and substitute the following: "preserve, or reserve that:"

AND

Page 2, delete line 29, and substitute the following:

"preservation, care, repair, or restoration of the monument.

(c)(l) An entity exercising control of public property which is a monument or on which a monument described in subsection (a) of this section is situated may petition the Arkansas History Commission for a waiver of the requirements of subsection (a) of this section.

(2) A petition for a waiver authorized by subdivision (c)(1) of this section shall:

(A) Be in writing; and

(B) State the reason the waiver is necessary.

(3) The commission may:

(A) Grant a petition for a waiver by a majority vote of those present and voting at a regularly scheduled commission meeting; and

(B) Except if the monument is a city park, include reasonable conditions and instructions to ensure that the monument is preserved to the greatest extent possible.

(d) A park commemorating any of the wars or conflicts listed in subsection (a) of this section shall not be renamed."


AND

Page 2, delete lines 32 through 35, and substitute the following: "(a) This subchapter does not apply to:

(1) A temporary exhibit; or

(2) Public property under the control of, or acquired by: (A) The State Highway Commission that may interfere with

the construction, maintenance, or operation of the public transportation system;



(B) The Department of Parks and Tourism that may interfere with the construction, maintenance, or operation of a public facility; or (C) The Department of Arkansas Heritage."
