INTERFERENCE WITH EMERGENCY MEDICAL
SERVICES PERSONNEL OR FIRST RESPONDERS;
AND ESTABLISHING CIVIL LIABILITY."

AND

Delete SECTIONS 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 in their entirety

AND

Page 5, delete line 36

AND

Page 6, delete lines 1 through 6, and substitute the following: "responder; or

(2) A riot or the activity of a rioter under § 5-71-201 et seq., may bring a civil action against the rioter or a person or entity that incites the riot."
