Page 2, delete lines 1 through 6, and substitute the following: "(b)(1) Consistent with the rules of the Supreme Court, the Administrative Office of the Courts is encouraged to individually track or design a method to track and accumulate data on the familial or residential status of the victim of a sex offense in relation to the offender. (2) A method designed under subdivision (b)(1) of this section shall: (A) Indicate whether the victim was a family or household member of the offender at the time of the sex offense; and (B) Protect against revealing the identity of the victim, either directly or indirectly."
