(3) Actions or transactions <u>specifically</u> permitted under laws administered by the Insurance Commissioner, the Securities Commissioner, the State Highway Commission, the Bank Commissioner, or other regulatory body or officer acting under statutory authority of this state or the United States, unless a director of these divisions specifically requests the Attorney General to implement the powers of this chapter; or"

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code \S 4-88-102, concerning definitions applied to"
