Subtitle of House Bill No. 2080

CONCERNING SEXUAL ASSAULT MEDICAL LEGAL EXAMINATIONS; AND CONCERNING THE
COLLECTION AND TESTING OF DNA DURING A CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2080

Amend House Bill No. 2080 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-403(b)(1), concerning a victim's being exempt from paying for a medical-legal examination, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1)(A) All victims shall be exempted from the payment of expenses incurred as a result of receiving a medical-legal examination ~~provided the victim must receive~~ if the victim receives the medical-legal examination within ~~seventy two (72)~~ ninety-six (96) hours of the attack.

(B) However, the ~~seventy two hour~~ time limitation of ninety-six (96) hours may be waived if the victim is a minor or if the Crime Victims Reparations Board finds that good cause exists for the failure to provide the ~~exam~~ medical-legal examination within the required time."
