Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2270

Amend House Bill No. 2270 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

12-12-110. Body cameras.

- (a) As used in this section, "body-worn camera" means an electronic device worn on a person's body that records both audio and video. (b)(1) A state or local law enforcement agency shall implement the use of body-worn cameras under guidelines to be established by the Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training.
- (2) The commission may adopt rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this section."
