Subtitle of House Bill No. 2270

CONCERNING BODY CAMERAS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS; AND TO ESTABLISH
INCENTIVES FOR THE USE OF BODY CAMERAS AND BODY CAMERA DATA STORAGE.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2270

Amend House Bill No. 2270 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

12-12-110. Body cameras.

(a) As used in this section, "body-worn camera" means an electronic device worn on a person's body that records both audio and video. (b)(1) A state or local law enforcement agency shall implement the use of body-worn cameras under guidelines to be established by the Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training.

(2) The commission may adopt rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this section."
