Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 148

Amend Senate Bill No. 148 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 9, and substitute the following: "AN ACT TO"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO CREATE BORN-ALIVE INFANT PROTECTION."

AND

Delete SECTION 2 in its entirety

AND

Page 2, delete 26 through 33, and substitute the following:

"(1)(A) "Abortion" means the act of using or prescribing any instrument, medicine, drug, or other substance, device, or means with the intent to terminate the clinically diagnosable pregnancy of a woman with knowledge that the termination by those means will with reasonable likelihood cause the death of the unborn child.

(a)(1) is not an abortion if the use, prescription, or means is performed with the intent to:

(i) Save the life or preserve the health of the

unborn child;

(ii) Remove a dead unborn child caused by

spontaneous abortion; or

(iii) Remove an ectopic pregnancy;"

AND

Page 3, delete line 8, and substitute the following:



"(b) A physician, other healthcare professional, or other person shall
not deny or"
AND
Page 3, delete line 15, and substitute the following: "(c) A physician, other healthcare professional, or other person shall
not deprive an"
AND
Page 5, delete lines 2 and 3, and substitute the following: "(3) Alter generally accepted medical standards."
AND
Appropriately renumber the sections of the bill
