Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 179
Amend Senate Bill No. 179 as originally introduced:
Page 2, delete lines 20 through 25, and substitute the following: "(r)(1)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (r)(1)(B) of this section, an educator whose license has been revoked may petition the State Board of Education for reinstatement of the license after the greater of: (i) One (1) year from the date of revocation; or (ii) One-half (1/2) of the time period of the
revocation has lapsed.
(B) An educator shall not be eligible to petition for
reinstatement under subdivision (r)(1)(A) of this section if the basis for
the revocation of the educator's license was an inappropriate relationship
between the educator and one (1) or more students that met or was demonstrated by a preponderance of the evidence to be intended to culminate
in the definition of sexual abuse as defined in § 12-18-103(20)(D)."
