PERMITTING ACT 309 INMATES IN THE CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION WHO ARE HOUSED IN A COUNTY JAIL TO WORK FOR LOCAL NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS.

Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 273

Amend Senate Bill No. 273 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 12, and substitute the following: "ORGANIZATIONS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"PERMITTING ACT 309 INMATES IN THE CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION WHO ARE HOUSED IN A COUNTY JAIL TO WORK FOR LOCAL NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY."

AND


Immediately following SECTION 1, add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Act 309 inmates are currently</u> <u>a valuable resource for local jails and political subdivisions; that Act 309</u> <u>inmates should be available for use by local nonprofit organizations; and</u> <u>that this act is immediately necessary because a number of nonprofit entities</u> <u>can immediately benefit from the assistance of Act 309 inmates. Therefore, an</u> <u>emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for</u> <u>the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become</u> <u>effective on:</u>

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
