Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 302

Amend Senate Bill No. 302 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete line 3, and substitute the following: "<u>the Arkansas State Medical Board.</u> <u>(3) A licensing board that licenses practitioners who have the</u> <u>authority to prescribe may adopt rules:</u> <u>(A) Requiring practitioners to check the information in</u> <u>the Prescription Monitoring Program when prescribing a Schedule III drug or a</u> <u>benzodiazephine; and</u> <u>(B) Placing quantity limits on a prescription for any</u> <u>controlled substance.</u>"
