Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 302

TO AMEND THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG MONITORING PROGRAM; AND TO REQUIRE PROFESSIONAL
LICENSING BOARDS TO PROMULGATE RULES REQUIRING PRACTITIONERS TO ACCESS THE
PRESCRIPTION DRUG MONITORING PROGRAM.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 302

Amend Senate Bill No. 302 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete line 3, and substitute the following:

"the Arkansas State Medical Board.

(3) A licensing board that licenses practitioners who have the
authority to prescribe may adopt rules:

(A) Requiring practitioners to check the information in
the Prescription Monitoring Program when prescribing a Schedule III drug or a
benzodiazepine; and

(B) Placing quantity limits on a prescription for any
controlled substance."
