Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 78

Amend Senate Bill No. 78 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 7 through 14, and substitute the following: "findings of the analysis to:

(A) The Governor;

(B) The House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and

Labor; and

(C) The Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and

Labor.

(2) The report shall include a recommendation as to whether the State of Arkansas should participate in the compact."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 19 through 28, and substitute the following: "the compact.

(d)(1) On or before July 1, 2018, the board shall issue recommendations regarding any legislation needed based upon the recommendations of the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor and the Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor to:

(A) The Governor;

(B) The Legislative Council;

(C) The House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and

Labor; and

(D) The Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and

Labor.

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. Full text of compact.

As directed in Section 1 of this act, the Arkansas State Medical Board shall study the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact as set out below:
