TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE CODIFICATION BY REFERENCE.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1163

Amend House Bill No. 1163 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 25, delete "the code" and substitute "the municipal code"

AND

Page 1, line 26, delete "the code" and substitute "the municipal code"

AND

Page 1, line 28, delete "clerk of" and substitute "clerk or recorder of"

AND

Immediately following SECTION 1 of the bill, add the following sections: "SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-55-702 is amended to read as follows: 14-55-702. Copies of <u>municipal</u> code <u>or revision</u> filed.

Upon the adoption of any municipal code or revision, three (3) copies of it the municipal code or revision shall be filed and maintained in the office of the city clerk or recorder.

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 14-55-704(b) is amended to read as follows: 14-55-704. Amendment of <u>municipal</u> code <u>or revision</u> authorized.
- (a) <u>Municipal codes or revisions A municipal code or revision</u> may be amended from time to time by ordinances duly enacted and published as required by law and passed in such form as to indicate the intention of the legislative body of the city to make them a part of the <u>municipal</u> code or revision.
- (b)(1) When so passed, copies of the ordinances shall be inserted in the copies of the <u>municipal</u> code or revision maintained by the city clerk <u>or recorder</u>, and the ordinances shall be deemed <u>are</u> a part of the <u>municipal</u> code or revision and <u>shall</u> have the same force and effect as if included therein at the time of the original adoption of the <u>municipal</u> code or revision.
 - (2) However, under this section any amendment shall not be

deemed to give any amending ordinance retroactive effect <u>Under this section</u>, an amendment does not give an amended ordinance retroactive effect."
