Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1301

Amend House Bill No. 1301 as originally introduced:

Page 3, line 31, delete "<u>a one-year temporary and provisional occupational</u> <u>licensure</u>" and substitute "<u>a temporary and provisional occupational licensure</u> <u>for ninety (90) days or longer</u>"

AND

Page 3, line 33, delete "<u>licensure in</u>" and substitute "<u>licensure that is</u> substantially similar to practice in the field of his or her occupation or profession in"

AND

Page 4, line 2, delete "<u>individual to</u>" and substitute "<u>individual who is</u> sufficiently competent in his or her field to"

AND

Page 4, line 31, delete "17-36-304," and substitute "17-36-304, 17-42-305,"

AND

Page 4, delete line 35, and substitute the following:

"reciprocity provisions under subdivision (g)(1) of this section.

(h) An occupational licensing entity may enter into written agreements with similar occupational licensing entities of another state, territory, or district of the United States as necessary to assure for licensees in this state have comparable nonresident licensure opportunities as those opportunities available to nonresidents by occupational licensing entities in this state."
