Subtitle of House Bill No. 1417

TO AMEND THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT OF 1967 TO PROTECT THE IDENTITY OF CERTAIN
PERSONS ASSISTING IN CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS; AND TO CREATE AN EXEMPTION OF THE
FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT OF 1967.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1417

Amend House Bill No. 1417 as originally introduced:

Delete Representatives M. Gray, Slape, Vaught as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Add Representatives Watson, M. Gray, Slape, Vaught as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Page 1, line 12, delete "OT" and substitute "TO"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO AMEND THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT
OF 1967 TO PROTECT THE IDENTITY OF
CERTAIN PERSONS ASSISTING IN CRIMINAL
INVESTIGATIONS; AND TO CREATE AN
EXEMPTION TO THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION
ACT OF 1967."



Page 1, delete lines 31 through 36, and substitute the following:

"knowledge of the individual's assistance as described in subdivision (b)(24)(A)(i) or (b)(24)(A)(ii) of this section, records containing information that could reasonably be used to identify an individual who is assisting or has assisted a governmental entity in one (1) or more investigations, whether open or closed, of matters that are criminal in nature, if:

(i) The individual is a confidential informant;

(ii) The individual is a confidential source;

(iii) The individual's assistance is or was provided under an assurance of confidentiality; or

(iv) The individual's assistance was not provided under an assurance of confidentiality, and disclosure of the individual's identity could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of the individual or a member of the individual's family within the first degree of consanguinity."

Page 2, line 1, delete "identifying"

AND

Page 2, line 2, delete "information" and substitute "information that could reasonably be used to identify an individual"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 8 and 9, and substitute the following:

"driver's license number, or other government-issued number specific to him or her;

(v) The individual's work or personal contact information; and

(vi) Any other information about the individual that"
