Subtitle of House Bill No. 1512

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS PLANT ACT OF 1917; AND TO CLARIFY AN EGREGIOUS VIOLATION IN
RELATION TO CERTAIN HERBICIDES.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1512

Amend House Bill No. 1512 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 11, delete "HERBICIDES;" and substitute "HERBICIDES; TO DECLARE
AN EMERGENCY;"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS PLANT ACT OF 1917;
TO CLARIFY AN EGREGIOUS VIOLATION IN
RELATION TO CERTAIN HERBICIDES; AND TO
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY."

AND

Immediately following SECTION 1, add an additional section to read as
follows:

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that delay in implementation of
this act would hinder the State Plant Board from enforcing egregious
violations during the 2019 growing season, which could have a detrimental
impact on the state's agricultural economy. Therefore, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the



preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.

The Amendment was read the first time, rules suspended and read the second time and
