TO ENSURE THAT PERSONS LICENSED TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OR
ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT RESCUE SERVICES MAINTAIN CONTINUAL NATIONAL EMERGENCY
MEDICAL SERVICES CERTIFICATION.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1547

Amend House Bill No. 1547 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 33 and 34, and substitute the following:

"(B) After the effective date of this section, an applicant seeking initial licensure or renewal of licensure shall be certified by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians for the particular emergency medical services personnel license that the applicant is applying for on the state level.

(C) An individual who is licensed as emergency medical services personnel before the effective date of this section is not required to be certified by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians to renew a license if he or she has never been certified by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians or is not eligible for reinstatement of certification by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians;"
