Subtitle of House Bill No. 1839

TO PROHIBIT A MINOR FROM PURCHASING A PREPAID MOBILE DEVICE; AND TO ESTABLISH THE
PREPAID MOBILE DEVICE PROTECTION ACT.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1839

Amend House Bill No. 1839 as originally introduced:

Delete the title in its entirety and substitute:

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE PREPAID MOBILE DEVICE PROTECTION ACT; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO ESTABLISH THE PREPAID MOBILE DEVICE
PROTECTION ACT."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 34 through 36

AND

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 12, and substitute the following:

"(2)(A) "Person" means an individual who is not related to a
minor.

(B) "Person" does not mean a parent or grandparent,
including without limitation a biological parent, adoptive parent,
stepparent, fictive kin, legal guardian, temporary guardian, or other legal
custodian of a minor;"

AND

Page 2, line 13, delete "(4)" and substitute "(3)"

AND



Page 2, line 15, delete "~~services;~~" and substitute "services; and"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 16 through 21

AND

Page 2, line 22, delete "~~(8)~~" and substitute "(4)"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 26 through 36, and substitute the following:

"4-118-103. Prepaid mobile device.

It is unlawful for a person:

(1) To purchase a prepaid mobile device or refill a prepaid mobile device with wireless communication services on a previously purchased prepaid mobile device for a minor in this state; or

(2) To provide funds to a minor for the purpose of purchasing a prepaid mobile device or refilling a prepaid mobile device with wireless communication services on a previously purchased prepaid mobile device in this state."

AND

Page 3, delete lines 1 and 2

AND

Page 3, delete lines 6 through 8, and substitute the following:

"prepaid mobile device or wireless communication services for a minor or provides funds to a minor for the purpose of purchasing a prepaid mobile device or refilling a prepaid mobile device with wireless communication services on a previously purchased prepaid mobile device shall be guilty of a violation and upon conviction shall be fined no less than one hundred"
