A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO REQUIRE THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEET EACH YEAR IN A REGULAR SESSION.

Amendment No. 1 to House Joint Resolution 1029

Amend House Joint Resolution No. 1029 as originally introduced:

- Page 2, delete lines 20 through 31 and substitute the following:
- "(a) A regular biennial session in an odd-numbered year shall not exceed sixty (60) calendar days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly. The \underline{A} regular biennial session in an odd-numbered year shall not exceed seventy five (75) calendar days in duration, unless extended by a vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$) of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly.
- (b) A fiscal regular session in an even-numbered year shall not exceed thirty (30) calendar days in duration, except that by a vote of three-fourths (3) of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly a fiscal regular session in an even-numbered year may be extended one (1) time by no more than fifteen (15) calendar days.
- (c) Provided, that this section shall not apply when impeachments are pending."

Page 3, line 1, delete "following a general election" and substitute "in an odd-numbered year"

AND

Page 3, line 29, delete "following a general election" and substitute "in an odd-numbered year"

AND

Page 4, line 11, delete "following a general election" and substitute "in an odd-numbered year"
