Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 169 CONCERNING THE TERM OF A DISTRICT JUDGE.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 169

Amend Senate Bill No. 169 as originally introduced:

Immediately following SECTION 1 of the bill, add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>(a) The enabling legislation for Arkansas</u> <u>Constitution, Amendment 80, did not contain language concerning the date of</u> <u>the first election for district judges under Arkansas Constitution, Amendment</u> <u>80, though the first election for district judges after passage of Arkansas</u> <u>Constitution, Amendment 80, occurred at the 2004 general election.</u>

(b) To avoid confusion in some areas of the state concerning the cycle for elections of district judges, the next election for a district judge shall be held at the 2020 general election."
