Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 287 Amend Senate Bill No. 287 as originally introduced: Page 1, delete lines 29 through 35, and substitute the following: "(2) A child raised under constant adult supervision may miss opportunities for growth that will negatively impact his or her mental and physical development; (3) The alarming rise of childhood obesity and diabetes is almost certainly linked to an increase in the sedentary lifestyle and lack of physical activity for children today, which is often encouraged by parents and guardians, including without limitation by insisting on driving their children to school;" AND Page 5, line 19, delete "within the previous three (3) years" AND Page 5, delete lines 24 through 27, and substitute the following: "(c) The investigator reviews the prior history of child maltreatment related to the family of the child and to the offender and determines that the health and safety of the child can be assured without further investigation by the Department of Human Services or the Department of Arkansas State Police; and"
