Page 7, delete lines 6 through 19, and substitute the following:

"(2)(A) Any The county, municipality, school district, or other local taxing unit shall have first published notice of its intention to receive bids one (1) time each week for not less than two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the county in which the proposed improvements are to be made. or in a trade

(B) In addition to the publication of notice required under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section, the county, municipality, school district, or other local taxing unit:

(i) May also publish notice in a trade journal reaching the construction industry; and

(ii) If the county, municipality, school district, or other local taxing unit is accepting electronically submitted bids, shall also post notice on the website of a vendor selected under the Fair Notice and Efficiency in Public Works Act, § 22-9-901 et seq."

AND

Page 7, delete lines 23 through 35, and substitute the following:

"(2)(A) If there is $\frac{1}{1}$ 0 newspaper regularly published in the county in which the proposed work is to be done, the notices may be published in any newspaper having a general circulation in the county.



- (B) In addition to the publication of notice required under subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section, the county, municipality, school district, or other <u>local taxing unit:</u>
- (i) May also publish notice in a trade journal reaching the construction industry; and
- (ii) If the county, municipality, school district, or other local taxing unit is accepting electronically submitted bids, shall also post notice on the website of a vendor selected under the Fair Notice and Efficiency in Public Works Act, § 22-9-901 et seq."

AND

- Page 9, delete lines 12 through 20, and substitute the following: "weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the county in which the proposed improvements are to be made. or in a trade
- (2) In addition to the publication of notice required under subdivision (a)(1) of this section, the state agency or taxing authority:
- (A) May also publish notice in a trade journal reaching the construction industry; and
- (B) If the state agency or taxing authority is accepting electronically submitted bids, shall also post notice on the website of a vendor selected under the Fair Notice and Efficiency in Public Works Act, § 22-9-901 et seq."

AND

- Page 9, delete lines 25 through 36, and substitute the following:

 "(2)(A) If there is no not a newspaper regularly published in the county in which the proposed work is to be done, the notices may be published in any newspaper having a general circulation in the county.
- (B) In addition to the publication of notice required under subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section, the state agency or taxing authority:
- (i) May also publish notice in a trade journal reaching the construction industry; and
- (ii) If the state agency or taxing authority is accepting electronically submitted bids, shall also post notice on the website of a vendor selected under the Fair Notice and Efficiency in Public Works Act, § 22-9-901 et seq."
