Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 515

Amend Senate Bill No. 515 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 33 through 36, and substitute the following:

"(i) Is located on public property and has been erected for, or named or dedicated in honor, of a historical person, historical event, military organization, or military unit, including without limitation:"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 19 through 22, and substitute the following:

"(ii) Is located on public property and has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

(B) "Monument" does not include a:

(i) Temporary exhibit;

(ii) Temporary structure; or

(iii) Street sign;"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 28 through 30, and substitute the following: "22-3-2105. Penalty.

 \underline{A} person who knowingly violates this subchapter upon conviction is guilty of a:

(1) Class A Misdemeanor if:

(A) The value of the property is more than five hundred dollars; and

(B) The damage or repair cost to the monument or memorial is more than one hundred dollars (\$100).

(2) Class D Felony if:

(A) The value of the property is more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000); and



(B) The damage or repair cost to the monument or memorial is more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000); and

(C) The person has been previously convicted of a Class A Misdemeanor under this chapter."
