Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 66

Amend Senate Bill No. 66 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 15, delete "CLARIFY" and substitute "TO CLARIFY"

AND

Page 1, line 16, delete "MAKE" and substitute "TO MAKE"

AND

Page 9, delete line 28 and substitute the following:

"(E) A 911 public safety communications center"

(2)(A) "Operate a motor vehicle" or "operating a motor vehicle" means driving a motor vehicle on a public road, street, or highway.

(B) "Operate a motor vehicle" or "operating a motor vehicle" does not mean driving or operating a motor vehicle:

(i) That is temporarily stationary because of the driver's or the operator's response to traffic, a traffic light, a stop sign, or yield sign; or

(ii) That has been pulled over to the side or off of a public road, street, or highway and stopped by the driver in a location where the motor vehicle may safely remain stationary."

Page 9, line 29, delete "(2)" and substitute "(3)"

AND

Page 9, line 32, delete (3)(A) and substitute (4)(A)

AND



- Page 11, delete line 28 and substitute the following: "operating a motor vehicle only in an emergency.
- (c) A law enforcement officer may stop or detain a driver of a motor vehicle solely to determine compliance with this section."

AND

Page 12, delete line 29 and substitute the following:

"Except as provided under § 27-51-1804, a driver of a motor vehicle is not to be stopped or detained solely to"
