Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 76

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING EMERGENCY TEMPORARY LOCATIONS FOR MEETINGS OF A GOVERNING BODY.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 76

Amend Senate Bill No. 76 as originally introduced:

Delete the title in its entirety and substitute the following: "AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING EMERGENCY TEMPORARY LOCATIONS FOR MEETINGS OF A GOVERNING BODY; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute the following: "TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING EMERGENCY TEMPORARY LOCATIONS FOR MEETINGS OF A GOVERNING BODY; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY."

AND

Immediately following SECTION 1 of the bill, add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there are meeting places of governing bodies across the state that are in disrepair; that often a meeting place needs to be closed and relocated temporarily; and that this act is immediately necessary because under current law a meeting place cannot be set up temporarily unless an emergency arises due to an enemy attack. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,

the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
