Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1005

Amend House Bill No. 1005 as originally introduced:

Add Senator A. Clark as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 2, line 25, delete "<u>a supporter</u>" and substitute "<u>one (1) or more</u> <u>supporters</u>"

AND

Page 2, line 26, delete "the supporter" and substitute "a supporter"

AND

Page 3, line 17, add a new subsection to read as follows: "(d) The following individuals shall not serve as a supporter: (1) An employer or employee of the adult with a disability; (2) An individual against whom the adult with a disability has or has had a restraining order; or (3) An individual providing direct paid support services to the adult with a disability."

AND

Page 4, delete lines 3 through 9, and substitute the following: "described in subdivision (b)(1) of this section;

(3) (A) A temporary or permanent guardian of the person or guardian of the estate is appointed for the adult with a disability. (B) The termination of a supported decision-making agreement under subdivision (b)(3)(A) of this section does not prohibit an adult with a disability from executing another supported decision-making agreement if the guardianship is terminated; or

(4) An order is entered that legally prohibits the supporter



from contact with the adult with a disability.

(c) A supporter who is a party to the supported decision-making agreement shall not interfere, impede, or prevent the Adult Protective Services Unit of the Department of Human Services from carrying out an investigation of abuse, neglect, or exploitation of the adult who is a party to the agreement."

Page 4, line 36, delete "fourteen (14)" and substitute "eighteen (18)"
