Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1015

Amend House Bill No. 1015 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 25, and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-71-101, concerning definitions used for offenses concerning riots and disorderly conduct, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(13) "Public monument" means an object on public land that commemorates a person or persons or an event or that has become relevant to a social group as a part of the social group's remembrance of historic times or is part of the social group's cultural heritage due to the object's artistic, historic, social, political, technical, or architectural importance.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-71-215 is amended to read as follows:"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 31 through 33, and substitute the following:

"(c) If an offense under this section is committed on the State
Capitol grounds, the Division of Arkansas State Police has sole jurisdiction over the arrest of a person for the offense."
