Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1265

Amend House Bill No. 1265 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 20, and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1001(a)(1)(A)(i), concerning
penalties for traffic violations involving school buses, is amended to read
as follows:

(a)(1)(A)(i) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section and $\$27-51-1004\frac{(e)}{(d)}$, a person who violates the provisions of this subchapter shall upon conviction be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or confined in the county jail not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both fined and imprisoned.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1004 is amended to read as follows:"

AND

Page 1, delete line 26, and substitute the following:
"not less than thirty feet (30') before reaching the school bus."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 3 and 4, and substitute the following:
"with subsection (a) or subsection (b) of this section while demonstrating a reckless disregard for the safety of the passengers of the school bus, the"
