Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1430 Amend House Bill No. 1430 as originally introduced: Page 2, delete lines 6 through 21, and substitute the following: SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-15-509(g), concerning a homeschooled student participating in interscholastic activities at a public school, is amended to read as follows: (g) A home-schooled homeschooled student who participates in an interscholastic activity may be: Required by the public school district superintendent to be (1) at school not more than only one (1) period per school day when participation in the interscholastic activity in which he or she participates does not require the student to be at the public school one (1) or more periods per school day; and (2) Transported by the resident school district to and from interscholastic activities as the resident school district transports other students who are enrolled in the resident school." AND Page 2, delete line 26, and substitute the following: "(j) An entity that is not statutorily created shall not impose additional criteria or requirements on a homeschooled" AND Page 2, line 27, delete "schooled"
